- Obtain a high school diploma

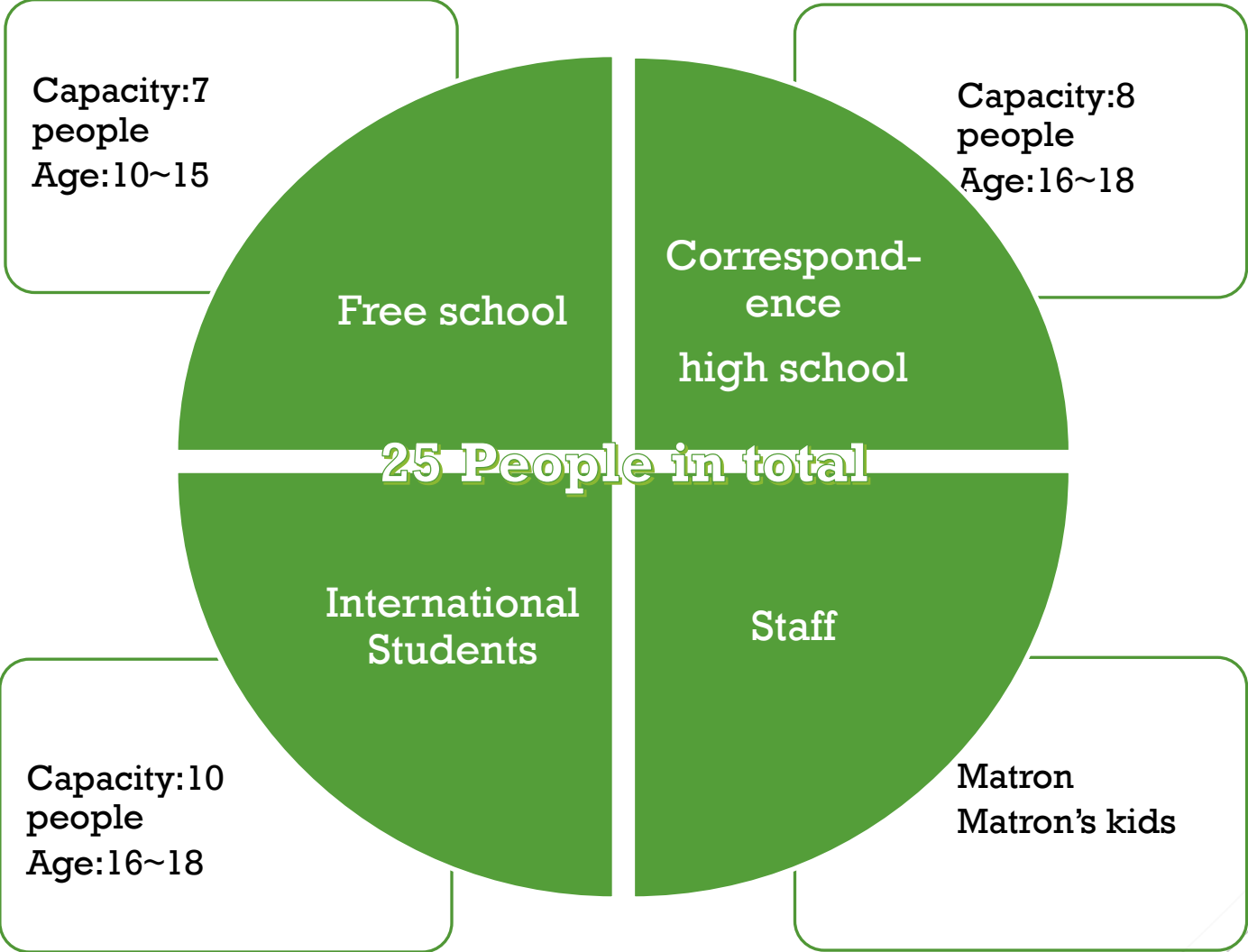
After-School Day Service
